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SUMMER EX 2025 NEEDS TEACHERS & AIDES!

- **Who and what we are:** Summer Exploration 2025 is a two-week Vacation Bible School for children from preschool through 8th grade. We use the facilities and run under the auspices of Montebello Plymouth Congregational Church (MPCC). In addition to teaching a Bible-based curriculum, we also include other various activities such as arts and crafts, games, cooking, physical activity, performing arts, field trips, and multimedia.
- When: Our program begins on <u>Monday</u>, July 7th and ends Sunday, July 20th. Program hours for kids are 9:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m. weekdays; however, staff are expected to arrive by 8:00 a.m. and stay until 5:00 p.m. for cleanup, meetings, and preparation. If sleepovers and trips are scheduled, the staff is expected to be on duty during these times as well. All staff are required to attend the finale performance at MPCC on Sunday, July 20th.
- **Training:** Staff members are required to attend training sessions June 30th July 3rd. These sessions are for learning and reviewing program procedures, going over curriculum, and meeting the other staff members. First aid training may be included or scheduled for at a later date.
- **Requirements:** All staff members must be able to work in a team ministry environment. They must also show maturity in their Christian faith as well as a willingness to work and play with youth. Teachers must be high school graduates; college or seminary student preferred. A teacher will work with the directors, other teachers, and our church pastor. Aides and junior aides must be high school sophomores or above. A letter of recommendation from a church pastor or lay leader will be required with your application. However, a letter of recommendation is not required if you are attending MPCC on a regular basis.
- **Compensation:** Upon completion of the program, scholarships will be awarded to all staff *enrolled in a college, trade tech or junior college*. Other staff will receive an honorarium, taxable according to state and federal laws. While the specific amount for scholarships and honorariums is not publicized, we will share a chart with the staff explaining the different factors that determine the amount given. If there are further questions, please feel free to contact the director.
- **How to apply:** Complete the application and emergency medical forms. These must be submitted no later than **Sunday, June 8th.** Applications will be accepted online, via mail, or via email. Again, a reference letter from a pastor or lay leader is required for all new applicants. A formal interview will then be set up with the director. A background check will be completed on all applicants, returning or new. Again, submitting an application or completing an interview does not guarantee a position, and incomplete applications will not be considered. The number of staffers that we hire is based on our total student enrollment.
